Rumpke Ohio Valley District Transfer and Recycling Facility

Rumpke Waste Inc. provides environmentally safe and cost-effective solid waste collection and recycling services to residents, businesses and organizations.

Ohio Valley District (OVD) - General Information

- The OVD facility currently employs 50 people.
 - Rumpke hires local people (96% live within 25 miles of the facility).
 - Rumpke created 34 new full-time jobs by opening this facility and plans to add more jobs in the future.
 - Positions include drivers, administrative, office, sales, general labor and management.
 - New positions are posted through the Workforce Development Resource Center, as well as online at www.rumpke.com.
- Rumpke opened the facility on Oct. 6, 2006.
- The facility receives 4,500 tons of trash and recycling per month.
 - Rumpke currently expects to recycle nearly 5% of the waste stream.
- The facility is open to the public Monday through Friday from 5 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturday from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.
- The facility is permitted to receive municipal solid waste (MSW), construction demolition debris (CDD) and recyclable material, such as cardboard.
- The facility operates in strict compliance with all local, state and federal environmental regulations.
- The facility is regularly inspected by several agencies, including Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Rumpke.
- Nearly 30 Rumpke waste and recycling collection trucks operate from this facility.
- The facility consists of two main buildings.
 - Recycling Facility and Transfer Station: 30,565 sq. ft.
 - Administrative Offices, Garage and Truck Maintenance: 15,170 sq. ft.

OVD Recycling Information

- **Buy-Back:** Rumpke purchases cardboard from customers.
 - The public buy back, for materials such as newspaper and metals, will open at a later date.
- **Drop Boxes:** Rumpke provides a drop box container on-site, 12 in Lawrence County and 17 in Scioto County where residents can drop off mixed recyclables for single stream processing.
- **Commercial Programs:** Rumpke offers free waste audits, an assessment of a company's waste stream conducted by a Rumpke representative, to identify materials for recycling.
 - Businesses often reduce costs through recycling programs.
- **White Goods:** Rumpke accepts items such as refrigerators and washers for free, but all CFCs must be removed by a certified technician prior to being accepted.
- **Tires:** Customers may bring tires to the facility, but they will be charged a fee per tire.
 - Tires are stored in a closed container.
 - Rumpke reserves the right to refuse tires based on storage capacity.

- Rumpke is a family owned and operated company, headquartered in Cincinnati, Ohio.
- Rumpke is one of the largest privately owned waste companies in the United States providing residential, commercial, industrial, construction and recycling services to customers in Ohio, Kentucky and Indiana.
- Brothers, William and Bernard Rumpke, founded Rumpke in 1932.
- Today, Bill Rumpke, Sr., William's son, serves as the president and CEO. Mark Rumpke, Bernard's grandson, presides over the Ohio Valley District as regional vice president. Approximately 50 family members are company employees.
- Rumpke employs more than 2,300 people throughout Ohio, Kentucky and Indiana, with nearly 1,500 employees in Ohio.
- Rumpke owns or operates nine landfills, six recycling centers and several transfer stations (facility where waste is consolidated before being hauled to landfills).

- The Environmental Industry Association inducted Rumpke's Founders, William and Bernard, into the waste industry's Hall of Fame.
- Rumpke won the 2005 Torch Award for Marketplace Ethics from the Cincinnati Chapter of the Better Business Bureau, which includes Lawrence County, Ohio.
