Rock Hill Schools Launch Recycling Program Rumpke Recycling to Conduct Presentations at Rock Hill Local Schools

What:

The Rock Hill Local School District has partnered with Rumpke Recycling and the Lawrence-Scioto Solid Waste Management District (LSSWMD) to implement a new district-wide recycling program. To help launch the program, Rumpke Recycling representatives will conduct interactive presentations for the students, faculty and staff about the importance of recycling and the guidelines for the program.

When & Where:

Tuesday, March 30 (each assembly will last about 45 minutes)

Rock Hill High School at 8:50 a.m.

Rock Hill Middle School at 10:10 a.m.

Rock Hill Child Development Center at 1:15 p.m.

Rock Hill Elementary School at 2:30 p.m.

Who:

Rock Hill students, faculty and staff will participate in hands-on recycling presentations with Rumpke Recycling representatives, including Rumpke mascot Binny the recycling bin, and the LSSWMD.

How:

The interactive presentations will cover the proper disposal of garbage in landfills, the importance of recycling and what can be recycled. It also explores the “life cycle” of many products from the point of generation as a raw material to recycling or disposal.

Why:

The presentations will help kick-off the district’s new recycling program. Students will now be able to recycle the following materials at school: paper, cardboard, plastic bottles and aluminum and steel cans.
